Dear Dr. Walmer,

Thank you for the sample you sent. I received it on Friday, February 24.

On checking under the microscope, I found no live amoebae of any kind. I also plated the fluid with suspended cells in tissue culture dishes on Friday and examined them this morning. None of the suspended cells had attached. This was in sharp contrast with what I found with a sample I had received from Dr. Blount on February 16, from which I obtained several dishfuls of attached and growing cells. I did not find any amoebae in that sample, either, so far.

I am still keeping your sample in culture dishes and will continue to observe a few more days. If any interesting finding is made, I will certainly let you know.
